**Dr. Damjana Kastelic**

Dr. Kastelic is a project leader at the DKFZ investigating the use of nanobodies for novel diagnostic and therapeutic applications. She also serves as the member for PhD selection committee and thesis advisory board. In addition she enjoys training students and scientists to improve their scientific presentation and communication skills. Dr. Kastelic will host an interactive session covering topics such as 'How to choose the lab for my PhD' and sessions aimed at self reflection.

**Dr. Thomas Schwarz-Romond**

Dr. Schwarz-Romond is an executive publisher (Health Sciences) at Elsevier and has previously worked at the EMBO journal in the capacity of Publications Manager/Editor.

Dr. Schwarz-Romond will give a talk on his professional journey from science to publishing and will answer questions pertaining to his experiences and motivation for choices in his professional career.

**Dr. Tim Waterboer**

Dr. Waterboer is the Head of the Infections and Cancer Epidemiology group at the DKFZ. In the past he has worked as a Global Epidemiologist at Boehringer-Ingelheim and in the capacity of Senior Global Epidemiology Manager and Outcomes Researcher at Roche.

In his session, Dr. Waterboer will share with us his diverse experiences working in the industry.

**Dr. Yunhai Cui**

Dr. Cui is a Principal Scientist at Boehringer-Ingelheim where he heads an *in vitro* ADME laboratory specialized in Drug Transporters and Pharmacokinetics and had headed a Respiratory diseases research laboratory in the past.

Dr. Cui will give a talk on his job as a scientist and laboratory head in the industry and answer questions as to what one may expect in a career as a researcher in the industry.

**Dr. Hai-Kun Liu**

Dr. Liu is the Head of Helmholtz University Young Investigator Group - Normal and neoplastic CNS stem cells at the DKFZ.
