material will be accessible to Selection Committe of Major Cancer Biology (1<sup>st</sup> preference) and Major of 2<sup>nd</sup> preference (optional, you don't need to choose a 2<sup>nd</sup> pref. Major)

The more you tell us about your previous experience in research and the methods, techniques and skills commanded the better we can judge your suitability for our program.

- Reference letters are not required documents and they will only be of interest to us if they
  describe a lab project you did, the methods you learned and applied, etc. We are not so much
  interested to read about your personality and character because in the first round of preselection by evaluating the application documents this is not really relevant.
- If your Bachelor degree is not in the field of biosciences but, for example, medicine, biochemistry, or pharmacology, this may not have adequately prepared you for our study program. In such cases it is especially important to document to our Selection Committee the contents of your education and whether you have taken additional courses in relevant biological subjects to catch up.
- We give some credit for extracurricular activities and social engagement, but please do not send confirmations for every soccer tournament you have participated in since Kindergarten  $\oplus$ .

In 2023, the new software system heiCO had been implemented for application to all Heidelberg University programs — technical disturbances may still be expected, so do not wait until the last minute to submit your application!
