Invited speakers & Workshop

We look forward to an inspiring weekend!

Dr. Thomas Höger studied Biology in Kiel, Heidelberg and at the MIT. After completing his doctoral thesis at the DKFZ in 1991, he held research and management positions at BASF AG, Knoll AG and DZ Bank before becoming CEO of Apogenix AG in 2005. Dr. Höger will introduce Apogenix and answer questions during a joint panel discussion with Dr. Schmidt.



Dr. Martin Steins was awarded the medical degree in 1993 from the University of Münster. Besides his work as a medical doctor, he did research on haemostasis and antiangiogenic therapies. Since 2005, he is senior consultant in the Department of Internal Medicine and Oncology at the Clinic for Thoracic Diseases in Heidelberg. He will speak about Patient's and Physician's Perspective in Oncology.



Dr. Manfred Schmidt studied Biology in Hohenheim and obtained his PhD in Freiburg in the Department of Internal Medicine in 2000. He stayed as post-doctoral researcher and later became group leader. Since 2005, he is group leader and section head at the NCT and the DKFZ. As of 2014, he also works as CEO for GeneWerk GmbH.

Dr. Schmidt will introduce GeneWerk and take part in the panel discussion with Dr. Höger

Stefanie Gleising is a physiotherapist from Butzbach near Gießen. She was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2010. Despite developing severe bone and brain metastases, she has been in remission since 2015. She will speak about her perspective on cancer treatment.
