### iThenticate:

The use of the plagiarism software iThenticate ([www.ithenticate.com](http://www.ithenticate.com)) helps authors to ensure they have sufficiently cited their sources of written work before publishing or submitting, esp. for graduate students preparing to submit a thesis or dissertation. It is an instrument for quality assurance, the test is completely voluntary. This plagiarism detection tool applies text-matching algorithms to compare the fulltext of a given manuscript to published works and web content. The results include number-coded and color-coded highlighting of parts of the manuscript that correspond to matching sources in the iThenticate database. Currently, iThenticate only compares texts of the same language. Pictures, formulas, etc. cannot be verified.

### Check request form:

Before the test can be started various data security requirements have to be fulfilled. Each Author has to sign a request form (both sides!) for the testing of theses, dissertations or any kind of similar work, as well the supervisor. If several authors are involved, all have to agree to the testing. This form also contains a declaration of consent concerning the matter of data protection. Please, return it to the library. Each publication may only be tested once.

### Your publication:

Please forward your manuscript in an anonymised form (without front page, acknowledgement etc), all personal data should be erased beforehand as well as the references section. All common file formats are supported. We can't check documents (PDFs) that have been generated from LaTeX. If your document has been written in LaTeX, please provide us with a Plain Text document that only contains the text parts of the work. You will need to remove all formulas, tables and graphics!

### Test:

We load up your manuscript to iThenticate for the test. As soon as the report is available, you will receive a message from us. Results are usually delivered within one hour, depending on the document size. In addition, we create user accounts for each author. Login data will be sent to you directly by email from iThenticate with which you can log in to iThenticate yourself. Authors and supervisors are responsible for interpreting the test results. The percentage of found matches in the report may not be meaningful, as the system also shows false positive results that derive from text fragments being identical to each other. This is often the case with established terms, in the method section or with quotations.

**Please note that iThenticate does not determine whether a manuscript contains plagiarism. You are encouraged to look carefully at these portions to determine whether all sources have been properly cited.** As a result, iThenticate makes it easier for you to identify and attribute any material that may contain unintentional plagiarism.

### Completion:

After 14 days we remove all data and delete your user account in iThenticate. Upon request, supervisors can keep their account.
